### WHO:

DROM, INC. is as an agency licensed by the state of Maryland to provide community residential services and Personal Support services to individuals with intellectual and other developmental disabilities.

### WHAT:

DROM, INC. provides Residential Personal Support Services (PS) to support individuals with intellectual and other developmental disabilities to live independently in the community.

Personal Support (PS) is a DDA funded program that assists individuals with disabilities in all aspects of their lives. Individuals who need assistance residing in their own homes, rental units, or with family may need individual support to live as independently as possible. The services provided are based on a certain number of hours per week that are established based on individual needs.

The services rendered are based upon person-centered planning; individuals choose the goals and services they would like to receive.

Currently, we assist individuals with money management, home management, nutrition, meal preparation, obtaining resources in the community, taking individuals to medical appointments, parenting skills, getting involved in leisure activities, as well as all aspects of living on their own. All of our current PS individuals live in their own apartments, and with our support, are able to live independently in the community.

# SCOPE

### Personal Support Services

DROM PS stresses community integration and utilizes individually designed services to assist people with disabilities live independently, as part of their community. PS provides services to assist an individual in vocational activities necessary to enable that individual to live in the individual's own home, apartment, family home, or rental unit.
